



In accordance with MRA's Christian mission and dedication to forming students in mind, body, and spirit, MRA requires that students complete a minimum of 10 hours of community service per year they are enrolled as high school students at MRA.

### Schedule

MRA operates on a twosemester system, **178** days divided by two terms. Students sit for comprehensive exams at the end of each semester. The school day is divided into seven **52**-minute class periods that meet daily.
